

Iowa Crops & Weather Report - USDA

Statewide

Corn:

56% good or excellent compared to 77% last year(LY) at this time

98% planted / 89% emerged (76-79% emerged for 1st District) - some of that will need to be replanted due to water in fields, insects, disease, silt and root rot

Soy:

53% good or excellent compared to 78% LY at this time

86% planted (11% behind LY at this time) 63% emerged (24 % behind LY)

USDA predicts 10% of soy crops will need to be replanted
