Deadlines for filing claims with crop insurance agents are:

June 1st: corn

June 14th: soy

Late planting deadlines:

June 25th: corn

July 10th: soy

June 10-15 is a pivotal time for decision making:

- If covered by federal crop insurance, farmers may not plant at all and get prevented planting payment, or they may
- Replant original crop, but expect a 30% reduction in yields from shorter growing season, finally they can
- Replant substitute crop like soy, sorghum, millet which may not have as high per bushel return on investment

As soon as a farmer realizes the need to replant damaged/destroyed crops, they need to contact their insurer to assess damage prior to replanting. Insurance generally cover 60% of projected yields if there is no replanting to mitigate loss.
