

Braley Announces Davenport to Receive \$477,000 for Water and Sewer Infrastructure

Today, Rep. Bruce Braley (D-Iowa) announced that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) awarded \$477,000 to Davenport to continue design and construction of the West Side Diversion Tunnel. Braley secured this funding for the Diversion Tunnel in the 2007 Omnibus Appropriations Bill last December, and the EPA is now releasing the funding to Davenport.
