

## Dubuque County

Automating the Intensive Care Unit (\$1,000,000) - This project will automate the intensive care unit's research flow by providing a centralized electronic tracking device to monitor vital signs, patient alerts and physician orders. This automation is a key component in creating a system of comprehensive electronic health records, decreasing the cost of healthcare while significantly enhancing the quality, safety and efficiency of patient care.

Aviation Degree Equipment (\$750,000) - This project will provide a flight training device for aviation flight students, helping to ensure an adequate supply pilots trained with the most current technology. The University of Dubuque provides the only four-year aviation training program in Iowa, preparing and training Iowans as pilots.

Doctor of Nurse Practitioner (DNP) Program (\$656,513) - This project will help Clarke College provide a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree program to help train advanced practice nurses in Iowa. This program will help fill Iowa's critical need for primary care health providers, specifically in rural areas.

Great Rivers Center (\$2,000,000) - This project will create a national center at the National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium in Dubuque that will research and educate Iowans about the impacts of the Mississippi River and other rivers across the country.

Intermodal Facility (\$1,000,000) - This project will create one central transportation facility at the Port of Dubuque connecting several modes of transportation including rail, trails and transit. The project will create construction jobs, reduce traffic congestion, and help Dubuque better connect to the surrounding region.

Lock & Dam 11 Major Rehabilitation (\$4,500,000) - This project will complete the Stage III dam work, rehabilitating the deteriorating lock and dam built in the 1930s. The Stage III work create construction jobs, help prevent further dam deterioration, and help decrease future repair and upkeep costs.

Loras College Science Hall facility enhancements (\$500,000) - This project will upgrade the science hall's research centers, strengthening student and faculty research opportunities. These improvements will help professors train the next generation of Iowa science scholars and promote biological and environmental research in the First District.

Lower Bee Branch Creek Restoration Project (\$500,000) - This project will provide flood protection to over 1,150 Dubuque residents through the excavation and removal of soil to construct stabilized creek banks and create construction jobs.

Medium Crawler Tractor (\$8,750,000) - This project will provide funding for the Marine Corps to purchase new, updated Medium Crawler Tractors to support US forces in Afghanistan. The tractors are produced in the First District, creating good-paying jobs for hundreds of Iowans.

National Education Center for Agricultural Safety (\$229,031) - This project will provide interactive health and safety education for Iowa farmers, volunteer firefighters, EMS providers, and agricultural businesses. This program will provide youth safety training to over 300 Iowa kids and updated safety training to over 400 volunteer fire fighters and EMS providers in Iowa's First District.

Southwest Arterial Project (\$2,000,000) - This project will allow Dubuque to complete the final design report for the Southwest Arterial project, allowing the city to start design and construction of the Southwest Arterial.
