

Braley: China Decision to Ban Iowa Pork is a "Slap in the Face to Iowa Farmers"

Today, Rep. Braley issued a statement responding to China's decision to ban Iowa pork.

Washington, DC - Today, Rep. Bruce Braley (D-Iowa) released the following statement on China's reported ban of Iowa pork imports:
